<b>Welcome guests:</b>	Margy Lindquist (NRCS), Mark and Betty Rochefort (Cambrians for Water)
<b>Additions/Changes:</b>	CARCD Report, Chuck Pritchard.
<b>Public comments:</b>	Mark Rochefort (Cambrians for Water): Presented a brief overview of the grassroots organization Cambrians for Water, formed last August in response to construction and operation of water treatment plant on San Simeon Creek. Members Jim and Jim, with help from RCD staff, currently conducting water quality monitoring to determine effects of treatment plant. Robert Hartzell: Congratulations to Mike Broadhurst for receiving acknowledgement in local newspaper on winning RCD Director of the Year.

<b>Executive Director</b>	Devin Best: Report- Met with Ag Commissioner and CSLRCD to highlight who the RCDs are and what we do for the community. Highlighted areas to increase dialogue and support future efforts. Update on grant agreements for CalTrans 2, Parrish Restoration and Santa Rosa Creek Bank Stabilization projects. Meeting with County Planning Department to discuss water related issues throughout the district. Jan13th BOS Meeting- Presented a one page synopsis on Sustainable Groundwater Management Act. Feb 10 <sup>th</sup> - Joint presentation with CSLRCD to BOS scheduled with goal to clearly demonstrate how funds from the County are utilized and keep RCDs visible. SDSU study- RCD asked to help outreach to local groups to facilitate SLO Rangeland Project. GRAP Meeting- summary of recent meeting where initial outreach conducted regarding water quality standards for non-irrigated ag. Margy Lindquist distributed a GRAP meeting summary. Strategic Plan- Goals and objectives will be discussed next meeting. FRGP Update: \$16 million in funds annually statewide for projects focused on improving steelhead habitat.
<b>Conservation Tech.</b>	Amy Smart: Update on Santa Rosa Creek grant applications. Applications for funding Floodplain Restoration Design and Wetland Infiltration Basin Implementation will be submitted following release of FRGP 2015-16 PSN.

<b>Supervisor Meetings</b>	Mike Broadhurst: Met with four supervisors with Robert Hartzell over the last few months to discuss financial support from County and decision on Offset program.
<b>CARCD Report</b>	Chuck Pritchard: CARCD programs are moving forward, increasing level of RCDs activity. Devin Best comment: CARCD developing criteria to gauge RCD effectiveness and provide support grants
