- Which?
 - It depends on:
 - The location
 - The work
- Examples
 - Cities/Counties
 - Grading
 - Building
 - Encroachment
 - Alternative Review (AG)
 - State
 - Schools
 - Coastal Zone

- When
 - Always
 - Cities/Counties

- When is a SWPPP required?
 - Disturb 1 acre or more
 - But... less than 1 acre if part of a larger development
 - Linear Projects still one acre.
 - Includes: pipelines, electrical lines
- What do I do if I need a permit?
 - Obtain coverage under the General Permit
 Order 2009-0009-DWQ

PERMITS

- File a NOI
- Develop a SWPPP
- Get your grading, building or encroachment
 Permit
- Implement SWPPP
- File a NOT
